Directions to WVSU Capitol Center 123 Summers St., Charleston, West Virginia:

from Beckley: Take I-64 W/I-77 N to Charleston

(Partial toll road) Take exit 100 (Leon Sullivan Way). Go three stop lights to Quarrier St. and turn right. Follow Quarrier to the corner of Summers. 123 Summers St is on your left and a parking building is on your right, at that corner.

from Morgantown: I-79 S to Charleston. That merges into I-77 S and eventually I-64/77 South to exit 100 (stay far left as this exit is immediately after the merge) onto Leon Sullivan Way. Go three stop lights to Quarrier St. and turn right. Follow Quarrier to the corner of Summers. 123 Summers St is on your left and a parking building is on your right, at that corner.

from Wheeling: I-470 W onto I-70 W. Take exit 180A to merge onto I-77 S toward Marietta. Continue on I-77 South to Charleston and bear right on I-64 West for a very short distance to exit 58-C, following Bigley Ave into Pennsylvania Ave. Get in far right lane of Penn. and turn right at Virginia St. Follow Virginia Street for several blocks and eventually get in the left lane to turn onto Summers St. At the corner of Summers and Quarrier Sts. is the Capitol Center (123 Summers) and caddy-corner is a parking garage.
